### **Airgun target shooting – Associate membership summary.**

Shooting is restricted to non-fac airguns at innate targets only. No nighttime shooting, no live quarry shooting or exploding targets to be used. Shooting is permitted seven days a week except when clay shooting is in progress (e.g. Sunday mornings and other occasional dates as notified) or ground maintenance activities in progress (e.g. grass cutting, work parties).

Valid shooting personal insurance must be held and shown if requested by a Club officer.

When shooting it is, the individual associate members responsible to comply with the law and shoot safely and the Club will not be held responsible for any damage or injury caused, sole responsibility lies with the member.

The Club ground must be left clean, tidy and secure after use and associate members are expected to help on work party days when and if able to do so.

No driving or parking on Club ground except within the car park area and not beyond the Club house, without prior consent from a Club Officer.

These rules may be amended at any time, at the discretion of the Club Committee.

Associate members have no voting rights at Club AGM.
